

**PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO 4 YEAR
INTEGRATED B.A. / B.Sc. B.Ed.
(2022-23)**

1. 1. Application Process:

- a) The application form is available at www.fmcollege.nic.in. An applicant can download the form and take a print-out. The form has to be filled in all respects and the same has to be sent by Regd post addressed to Principal, F.M. Auto. College, Balasore or it can be submitted in the college counter between 11.00 AM to 2 .00 PM
- b) Application form is also available at the college counter on depositing a sum of Rs. 500/- as application fee and the money receipt is to be enclosed with application form. The application by post, the candidate is required to attach Bank Draft for Rs. 500/- drawn in favour of Principal, Fakir Mohan Auto. College, Balasore payable at Balasore.

1. 2. Documents to be attached with application

- HSC Mark Sheet, +2 Arts/ Commerce/ Science Mark Sheet
- Bank draft/ college money receipt in support of fee for application (Rs.500/-)
- Caste Certificate for SC/ST /PH Candidates, if applicable

1. 3. 1. Course Fee

The course fee of the programme is 40,000/- per annum. A candidate, selected to take admission, has to deposit the 1st instalment of 40,000/-. This is in addition to the college and the examination fees as decided in accordance with College/ University fee structure.

A student required to pay the course fee for the current session in the event of withdrawing CLC from the college during the continuation of the course.

2. 1. Principles of Selection

Admission to the Integrated B.A B.Ed/B.Sc B.Ed shall be done strictly on the basis of merit. Marks secured at 10th and the +2 (Higher Secondary) levels will be taken into consideration for preparing the merit list for admission to a stream in the following manner:

- i) 50% of marks secured at the 10th level
- ii) 100% of marks secured at the +2 level

For example a girl securing 300 out of 600 at the HSC and 300 out of 600 at the +2 level will have a score of 150+300=450.

The base marks for both the levels will be 600 each and students passing from Boards other than BSE and CHSE will have their marks calculated out of 600. There will be no selection of best 4 or best 5.

How ever, the Honours selection shall be made taking into account the marks of +2 level only

2. 2. Selection of core and elective subjects

a) After selection of the stream, a student has to choose a core subject. The college offers core teaching in the following subjects with 10 seats each.

English, Odia, History, Political Science, Geography, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Mathematics.

For admission to a particular core course, the merit list prepared earlier will be used.

2. 3. A student pursuing B.A B.Ed. must have the following electives

Elective 1/2 - English/ Odia

Elective 2/1 - History/ Geography/ Economics/ Political Science

3. Intimation

The list of applicants, found eligible for admission, will be available on the college website.

4. Admission procedure

The applicants have to be physically present in the college on dates mentioned in the Intimation letter to take admission. They must bring the following documents in the original along with their photocopies.

- i) HSC or Equivalent Certificate
- ii) HSC or Equivalent Mark Sheet
- iii) Higher Secondary or Equivalent Certificate
- iv) Higher Secondary or Equivalent Mark Sheet
- v) a) Caste/ Tribe Certificate, if any, from revenue officer not below the rank of Additional Tehsildar
- b) PWD Certificate from CDMO/SDMO/CMO of capital Hospital, BBSR.
- c) Ex-Serviceman Certificate from Zilla/ Rajya Sainik Board.
- d) SDP (Army/ Navy/ Air Force) Certificate from the Commanding Officer of the Unit
- e) CoM Certificate from the District Collector.
- vi) SLC/ CLC and Conduct Certificate from the Institution last attended
- vii) Migration Certificate for applicants passing from Boards other than CHSE, Odisha
- viii) 3 Passport size recent colour photos
- ix) Deposit slip for course fee and other fees.

5. Reservation

a) SC - 16.25%

b) ST - 22.5%

The reserved seats are not interchangeable between SC and ST

c) SC/ST applicants selected for admission on their merit shall not be counted against reserved seats.

d) However, any modification made by the Government on the reservation policy will be followed during admission.

e) PWD - 5%

f) ESM/ SDP/ CoM - 1%

- a) i) have passed +2 Arts/Commerce with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate; or

- b) have passed +2 science with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate with the subject combination of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at the +2 level;
- c) have passed +2 science with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate with the subject combination of Biology, Physics and Chemistry at the +2 level;

An applicant desirous of applying for both the streams have to use separate application forms and have to pay fees separately.
