

## **NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME**

Motto: **Not Me But You**

Enrolment: A total number of 100 students (50 boys and 50 girls) is to be enrolled for N.S.S from this College unit.

Aims of N.S.S.: To promote national consciousness and a sense of social responsibility and to inculcate discipline and a sense of dignity of labour among students. The normal duty of students enrolled for N.S.S. shall be to undertake the projects assigned to them on Sundays and other holidays. Altogether 25 such days will be utilised and students shall work for six hours a day. This will come upto man hours for each student during the term time. Besides this N.S.S. students will participate in camps where they will stay for about 7 days. This will enable the students to enjoy community life. At the end of the session certificates will be issued to students on the basis of their performance and completion of 240hrs in social service. F.M. Autonomous College has two units in N.S.S, a Boys' unit and a Girls' unit. N.S.S. Boys' unit and Girls' unit have taken up "*Mendhasul*" and "*Tulanga Sahi*" as the adopted villages respectively. The following welfare activities of NSS performed there are listed chronologically.

## **ROVERS AND RANGERS SCHEME**

Bharat Scouts and Guides has opened Rover Crew (for boys) in the College in 2013-14 session with an intake capacity of 24.

Motto: To promote good citizenship among the youth by developing their character, skill, habit and the spirit of service through outdoor activities.

This is accomplished by 1.Training young men in habits of observation, obedience and self-reliance. 2.Inculcation of loyalty and thoughtfulness through instruction and service to others. 3.Teaching young men services useful to the public and themselves. 4.Developing physical and mental ability through wholesome social contacts and activities. 5.Guiding young men to develop spiritual and social values.

## **YOUTH RED CROSS UNIT**

A Youth Red Cross Unit has been set up in the College since the session 1976-77. The objective of the organization is to inculcate among the students the ideals of peace and social service, especially in relation to their health and that of others. The aims are to promote health care, provide service to the sick and suffering and encourage international friendliness. A member of the teaching staff is nominated as counselor by the Principal.
