The F.M. College Gymnasium was established in 1996 with the financial assistance and support of the U.G.C. A multi-gym with 16 conditioning units, weight-lifting and other physical exercise units have been established in the Gymnasium inaugurated on 27.01.1996. The Gymnasium remains open on all working days (except vacation and public holidays) between 4 P.M. to 5.30 P.M. The membership of the Gymnasium is open to all student and staff of the college on payment of Rs. 100 as refundable caution money and subscription fee of Rs. 30 per month. The affairs of the Gymnasium shall be managed by a committee consisting of (1) Principal (ex-officio President) (2) Vice-President, Athletic club. (3) P.E.T. (member-secretary) and (4) two other members, to be nominated by the Principal. Members of non-teaching staff shall remain in-charge of the working session of the gymnasium on honorarium basis). The Principal is the final authority in all matters relating to the Gymnasium. Details rules are available at the Gymnasium.







The library is partially automated and it is now under process. Library has nearly 380 non-printed materials and other Reading materials for teaching and research.

(ix)	E-Resources	e-books and e-journals subscribed from INFLIBNET and N-Lit.

F.M. Autonomous College has a very spacious, well equipped Central Library with reference materials and texts housed in a three storey building. The library is fully equipped with E-learning facility of INFILBNET which covers a wide set of applications and processes, books, journals, magazines, newspapers etc.

- (1) Normally the Library remains open from 10.30 am to 5pm on all working days.
- (2) Students are required to submit their requisition slips in the library counter from 11 am to 4pm for books one day before the scheduled date of issue. But all 1st year and Commerce students of all classes are to submit the slip by 11am. Circulation of books will continue from 11 am to 4.30 pm but for 1st year and commerce students it will be from 11am to 3pm on all working days.
- (3) Magazines and periodicals will be issued in the Reading Room only according to availability between 11.00 am and 5pm on submission of identity and borrower-slip cards.
- (4) No book shall be taken out of the Library without the knowledge of the Librarian or until it has been properly entered in the Circulation Register and the entry attested by the borrower.
- (5) Every borrower should examine the condition of the material before it is issued to him/her. Otherwise, in case of mutilation discovered afterwards, the presumption will be against the borrower.
- (6) The maximum number of books and magazines that may be issued to various classes of borrowers is given below.

Books marked "Reserved Copy" shall not be issued without the specific permission of the Principal.

Members of the staff are allowed to borrow text books and reference books concerning their own department. If they want to borrow any text and reference book concerning departments other than their own, they are requested to take permission from the Principal and in that case they are allowed to borrow only two books at a time for a period of one month only.

(7) Books or periodicals must be returned in the Library counter and not to any library bearer. The Library will not be responsible for any book returned to anybody except the Librarian or the Assistant Librarian. All books borrowed from the Library should be returned before the summer vacation as per the O.E. code. Any book required by the Librarian for some reason should be returned forthwith.

(8) Overdue at the rate Rs. 1/- (Rs. One) per book so issued will be charged from each borrower for each day of delay in returning the book. A borrower against whom any due is outstanding will not be allowed to borrow books from the library until the book is returned and the fine paid.

(9) The Librarian shall report to the Principal the names of persons responsible for improper use of library books, such as making notes in the margin, tearing or removal of pages or pictures and dirtying or disfiguring the book in any way. The Professor in-charge will report cases to the Principal for proper action.

(10) There will be no restriction on the use of any book in the library, but certain books may be reserved by the Principal for exclusive use on the recommendation of the members of the teaching staff concerned.

(11) Books of reference, maps, current issues of periodicals, courses of studies and rare books will not be issued for use at home without the special permission of the Principal. So long as the following issue of a periodical is not received it is to be considered as the current issue.

(12) A book once issued to a borrower will be reissued to him only if no other borrower wants it.

(13) It is a very serious offence for a borrower to sign for another or borrow books in another's name. Students are therefore required to take the greatest care of their library cards and to report to the Librarian immediately if their cards are lost. A new card will be issued on payment so prescribed.

(14) Any book lost, damaged or defaced by a borrower must be replaced by him. If the book is not available, the borrower may have to pay an amount of Ten times of the catalogue price of the book. In case, the price cannot be ascertained the borrower should pay the amount fixed by the Principal. The Principal may impose a fine on a borrower for improper use of a book, journal and question papers.

(15) Those who use the library must observe strict silence and when they are obliged to speak to the Library staff, they should speak in a low voice.

(16) Students must return the library books/periodicals before filling up their application form for the Final Examination.

(17) Sticks, umbrellas and other personal belonging should not be brought into the Library premises. Spitting, smoking or sleeping inside the library and putting one's leg on the furniture are strictly forbidden. The Librarian will report to the professor in-charge all cases of incivility on the part either of the students or of the library staff and the professor in-charge will report such cases to the Principal.

(18) Those who use the library are supposed to have read the library rules and to have agreed to abide by them.

(19) One exclusive floor of the library has been reserved for references and journals. In this floor, college has created a heritage corner for two leading literary luminaries of India - 1. Manoj Das 2. Jayanta Mohapatra, the former being an Alumni and the latter an ex-faculty.

### REPROGRAPHY SECTION

There is a Reprography Section attached to the College Library which renders service by preparing a reprography copy in the form of photographic copies according to the needs of the staff, students, scholars of this college on payment of basis. The bonafide students and members of staff can avail themselves of the services from 2 pm. to 4.30 pm. on all working days. Only Journal articles, reports, pages of books, old question papers etc. can be reproduced in the form of Photostat copy according to the requirements of user.


