TOPIC : “NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY-2020: A WAY FORWARD FOR EDUCATION SYSTEM IN INDIA”

DATE: 07.08.2021 from 3.30 PM TO 5.30 PM THROUGH *GOOGLE MEET*

The IQAC Cell of the Fakir Mohan Autonomous College, Balasore organised a webinar on “**National Education Policy-2020: A way forward for Education system in India**” on dated 7th august 2021 from 3.30 to 5.30 PM. Prof. S. K. Baral, Professor of Commerce, Indira Gandhi National Tribal University(IGNTU), MadhyaPradesh graced the webinar as the Resource Person.

At the outset Dr.Sangita Sahu, Principal of the college welcomed the resource person and all the participants and presented a brief note on the topic. In her address she stated how the “National Education Policy 2020”, approved by the Cabinet of India on 29 July 2020 aims to revamp the education system of the world, making India a Powerhouse of Global awareness. NEP, a "student friendly policy" is aligned with the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and focuses on (a) access, (b) equity, (c) efficiency, (d) affordability and (e) transparency as the fundamental pillars of the New EducationPolicy(NEP).

The Resource Person discussed about the major steps taken by successive Governments to decolonise the education system after Independence through the University Education Commission(1948-49), Secondary Education Commission(1952-53), D.S.Kothari Commission (1964-66) and the National Policy on Education(1968). India has had three education policy to date. The first came in 1968 and the second in 1986. The NEP of 1986 was revised in 1992. The third is the NEP released in 2020 after almost thirty-four years. The New education policy focuses on thrust on “experiential learning and critical thinking”. There is a significant shift from the 1986 policy, which pushed for a 10+2 structure of school education, the new NEP pitches for a “5+3+3+4” design corresponding to the age groups 3-8 years (foundational stage), 8-11 (preparatory), 11-14 (middle), and 14-18 (secondary). This brings early childhood education (also known as pre-school education for children of ages 3 to 5) under the ambit of formal schooling.

One of the main goal of NEP-2020 is to increase GER (Gross Enrolment Ratio) in higher education to 50 percent by 2035 from the 26.3 percent in 2018. Prof Baral concluded his deliberation by quoting that NEP 2020 aims at sustainable development , there by transforming India into a global knowledge super power by making both school and college education more holistic, flexible and multi disciplinary.

Mrs. Mousumi Das Pattanayak, Coordinator of IQAC Cell introduced the esteemed Speaker to the august audience and vote of thanks was proposed by Mr.Sameer Kumar Behera. Almost 80 number of Regular as well as guest faculties participated in the seminar in virtual mode. The Question and answer session was very interesting. Dr.Subrat




